Pirate Popsicle Stick Puppet Craft

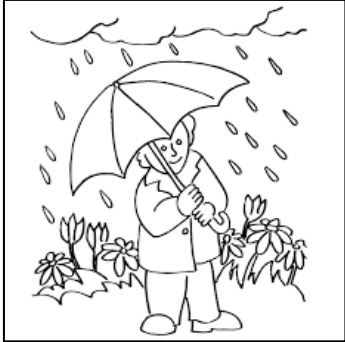
1. Color in the pirate ship.
