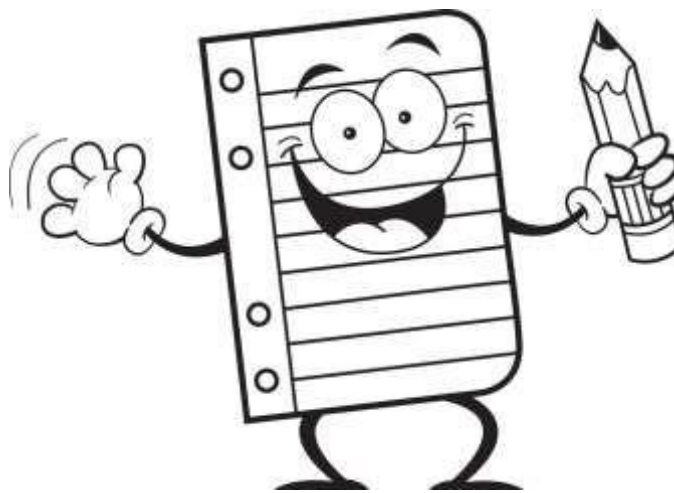

### fair ① adjective fairer, fairest

1 Something that is fair seems right because everyone is treated the same way. *It's not fair! Why does she always sit in the front?*

2 Fair can mean light in colour. *My sister has long, fair hair.*

### fair ② noun fairs

Fairs are set up with things like stalls, roundabouts, and other rides so that people can have fun.

### fairy noun fairies

In stories, fairies are tiny people who have wings and can do magic.

### fall verb falls, falling, fell, fallen

When something falls, it comes down suddenly. *The apple fell from the branch.*



### fallen See fall.

*I've fallen over and hurt my knee.*

### family noun families

A family is made up of parents, children, and grandchildren.

### famous adjective

Famous people and things are very well known.

### far adjective farther, farthest

Something that is far away is a long way away.



### farm noun farms

A farm is a piece of land for growing crops or keeping animals for food.

### fast adjective faster, fastest

Something that is fast can move quickly.



### fasten verb fastens, fastening, fastened

If you fasten something, you do it up. *You need to fasten your seatbelt.*
