

face noun *faces*
Your face is the front part of your head.

factory noun *factories*
A factory is a building where people and machines make a large number of things.

fail verb *fails, failing, failed*
If someone fails, they try to do something but cannot do it. *The pirates failed to find the treasure and had to leave without it.*

fair ① adjective *fairer, fairest*
1 Something that is fair seems right because everyone is treated the same way. *It's not fair! Why does she always sit in the front?*
2 Fair can mean light in colour. *My sister has long, fair hair.*

fair ② noun *fairs*
Fairs are set up with things like stalls, roundabouts, and other rides so that people can have fun.

fairy noun *fairies*
In stories, fairies are tiny people who have wings and can do magic.

fall verb *falls, falling, fell, fallen*
When something falls, it comes down suddenly. *The apple fell from the branch.*

fallen See **fall**.
I've fallen over and hurt my knee.

family noun *families*
A family is made up of parents, children, and grandchildren.

famous adjective
Famous people and things are very well known.

far adjective *farther, farthest*
Something that is far away is a long way away.

farm noun *farms*
A farm is a piece of land for growing crops or keeping animals for food.

fast adjective *faster, fastest*
Something that is fast can move quickly.

fasten verb *fastens, fastening, fastened*
If you fasten something, you do it up. *You need to fasten your seatbelt.*

Crocodiles are reptiles. They have four short legs, a long tail and a very big mouth with lots of sharp teeth. Crocodiles can swim very well so they live in the water, but they can move on land, too. They live in rivers and lakes in hot places like Africa or Australia.

Crocodiles eat other animals. They eat small animals like fish or frogs, but they can eat big animals, like a zebra or a gazelle, too. Sometimes they eat humans!



Female crocodiles lay eggs. When the babies hatch, the mother takes them carefully in her mouth to the water.
