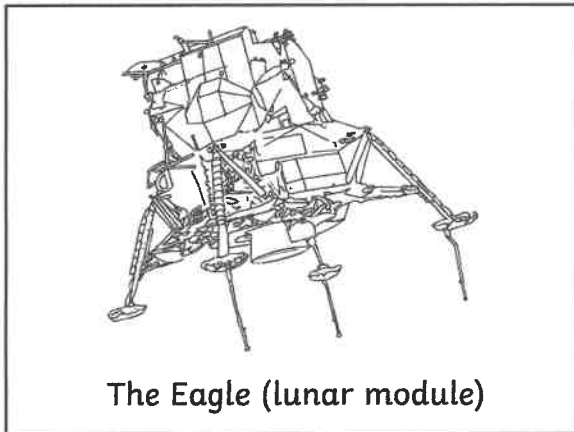
MEN ON THE MOON!

It's One Giant Leap...

21st July 1969

NASA astronauts Neil Armstrong and Edwin (Buzz) Aldrin became the first humans to walk on the Moon yesterday.

They travelled into space in the Saturn V rocket with Michael Collins and reached the orbit of the Moon on 19th July 1969. Yesterday, Michael stayed in the rocket doing experiments and taking photographs of the mission. Neil and Buzz entered the lunar module, which was nicknamed The Eagle.

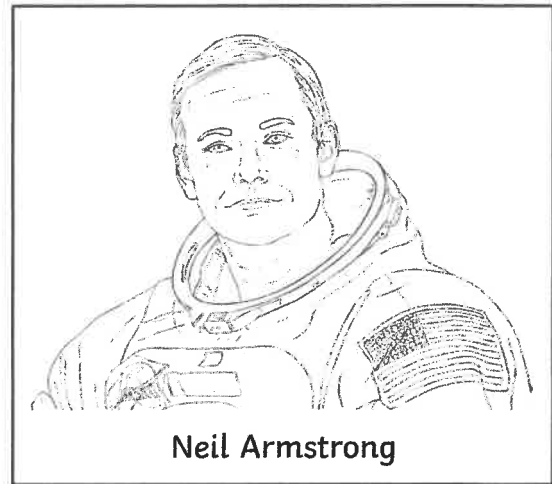


The Eagle (lunar module)

Neil and Buzz's job was to reach the Moon. The Eagle was heading towards a large crater but Neil took control and landed in a safe position.

They had a rest before Neil left The Eagle. He went down the metal stairs slowly. As he reached his left foot down to touch the Moon's dusty surface,

he said, "That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind."

Buzz joined Neil and they spent around two and a half hours exploring the Moon. Around 600 million lucky television viewers around the world watched them. They collected some Moon dust and rock. They also planted the American flag on the Moon. At first, this task did not go as planned but Neil and Buzz managed to place the flag so that it could be clearly seen.

The astronauts enjoyed moving around the Moon's surface. They jumped like kangaroos and leapt like gazelles! Neil said that it was not at all difficult to move around in low gravity.

When they re-entered the lunar module, their bulky spacesuits snapped off a switch. They fixed this using part of a pen before heading back to Michael in the rocket.

These astronauts made history and will be remembered forever for being the first men on the Moon.



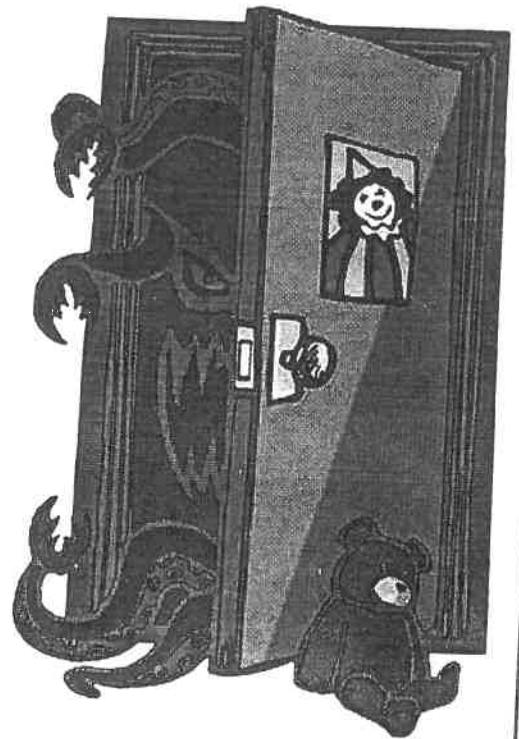
"Adam?" David asked in a groggy voice. "What are you doing in here?"

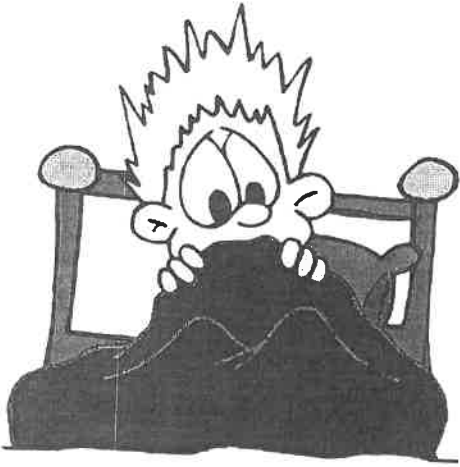
Adam tugged on David's arm. "There's something in my closet!"

The First Thanksgiving

The Thanksgiving holiday in the U.S. started with a celebration held in 1621. The Pilgrims and the Native Americans came together for a large feast.

The Pilgrims had left their home in England to come to America. They did not like the church in England. They wanted to start their own church. The Pilgrims sailed to America on a ship called the *Mayflower*. They arrived in what is now Massachusetts in November 1620. After a hard winter, the Pilgrims started their settlement. They called it the Plymouth Colony.

The local Native Americans were members of the Wampanoag tribe. The tribe gave the Pilgrims food. One of the tribe members was Squanto, who taught the Pilgrims to grow corn and catch fish.

After the Pilgrims harvested their corn and other crops, they celebrated with a large feast. Many Wampanoag tribe members visited and brought more food. They were happy that they had plenty to eat and were friends.

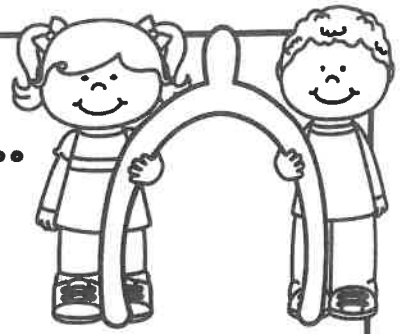

Mercutio fights Tybalt. Tybalt kills Mercutio! Romeo is so upset he fights Tybalt and kills him too!

The Prince of Verona is very angry and sends Romeo away. Juliet goes to Friar Lawrence for help.

“Here is a special drink. You will sleep for two days. Your family will think you are dead but you will wake up. Then you and Romeo can be free together.”

Friar Lawrence sends Romeo a letter to tell him the plan. But Romeo doesn’t get the message. He hears that Juliet is dead!

Romeo is so upset he buys some poison and goes to see Juliet.

“Now I will stay with you forever.”

Too late, Juliet wakes up! She sees what happened.

“Oh no! You didn’t leave any poison for me but here is your knife.”

Romeo and Juliet are both dead. Friar Lawrence tells the Capulets and Montagues what happened. They are so sad they agree not to fight any more.
