




Lucy is a nice child. She's eight years old and she's very untidy, her bedroom is a toyshop!

On the floor there's a train, a car and a lots of bricks, at the bottom of her bed there's a pram with a doll and on the shelf there's a spinning-top. What a mess!



A tip for a man who has a dog? A dog is a dog and a man is a man. Man, you eat ham. And the dog? Get him a tin or the leg of a hen!


