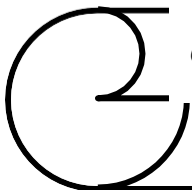

- But in Australia, winter is June, July and August.

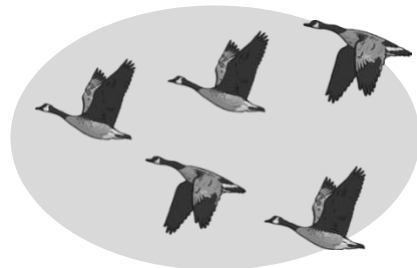
Nature in winter:

Reindeer have special hooves to help them walk on the ice and snow. They use their hooves to find food under the snow, too.

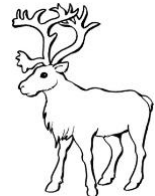
Male and female reindeer have antlers. Reindeer have their antlers for some months; then they fall off. New ones grow later. Reindeer move around in large herds from place to place to find food.

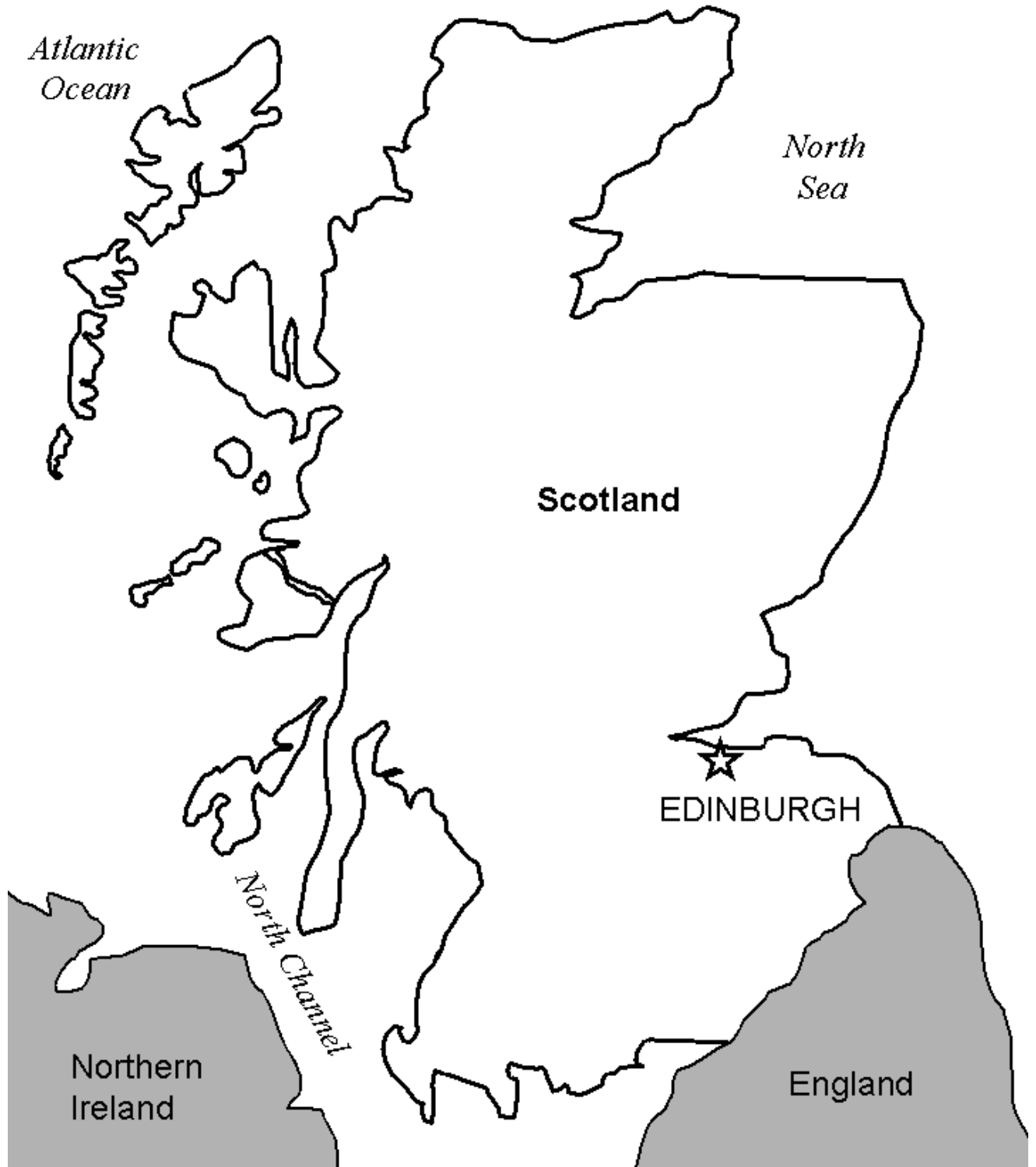

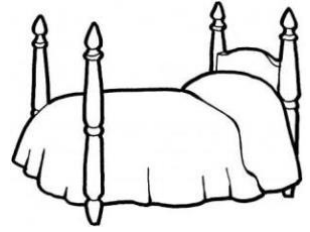

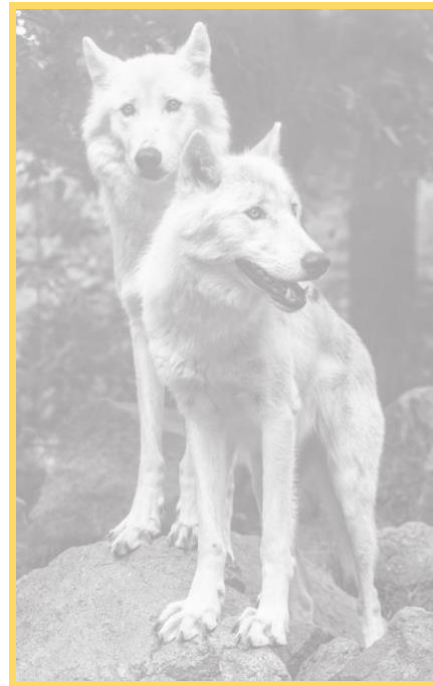
Wolves

A wolf is a type of wild dog which lives in groups, called packs. In the pack there can be from two to twenty wolves.

A baby wolf is called a cub. Each mother can have four to six cubs. They live for six to eight years in the wild but can live about sixteen years in zoos.

Wolves hunt for birds, fish, moose, deer and other mammals. They are carnivores, which means their main food is meat.

They live in North America, Europe and Russia.

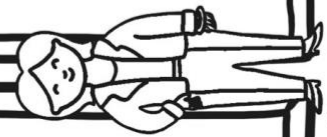

Growing Carrots

Do you like carrots?
Do you know how carrots grow?



Carrots are vegetables that grow in the ground. They can grow in a garden or in pots. They are usually orange but they can be yellow, white or purple, too. We plant the seeds in the spring because carrots grow best when it is warm. They take about three or four months before they are ready to eat. So we can pick them in the summer.

The root of the carrot is the part that we eat. It grows under the ground. Carrots have green leaves that grow above the ground but we don't eat the leaves.

We can eat carrots raw, in a salad or cooked. We can use carrots to make soup or juice, too. Carrots have fibre and vitamins, so they are very good for us.

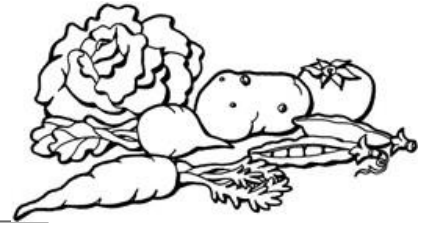

Oranges are citrus fruits, like lemons and mandarins. Oranges grow on trees. The trees grow in warm or hot places around the world. There are a lot of orange trees in Spain in places like Valencia or Sevilla.

Flowers grow on the trees. When there is enough rain and the sun is warm, the flowers grow into oranges. It takes about eight weeks for a flower to grow into an orange.

We can use oranges to make juice or marmalade, but we can eat a delicious orange, too!

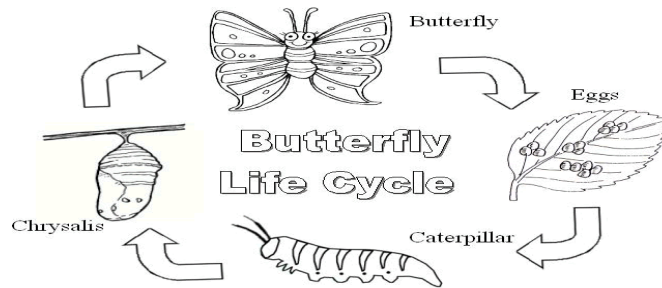

BUTTERFLIES

Butterflies are insects. They sometimes have bright coloured wings.

Butterflies have an interesting life cycle. They start as eggs. Then they grow into caterpillars. The caterpillars move into a cocoon and are called achrysalis. When the insect comes out of the cocoon, we call it a butterfly.

Butterflies can be found all over the world. Some butterflies migrate. The Monarch butterflies migrate about 5000 kilometres every year. They fly between Mexico and California.
