WAYS SHORT VOWEL SOUNDS ARE MADE

SHORT VOWELS

Short vowels are quick sounds.

cat



ONE SOUND

Each short vowel makes just one sound.

bed



HEAR IT

You can hear the short vowel in the middle of the word.

pig



SOUNDS SHORT

Short vowels are shorter than the letter name.

dog



NOT THE NAME

We say the sound, not the letter name.

sun



Remember: When a **vowel** says its **sound**, it is a **SHORT** vowel!

We usually think of pirates as people who sailed around the world in ships, had adventures and looked for treasure.



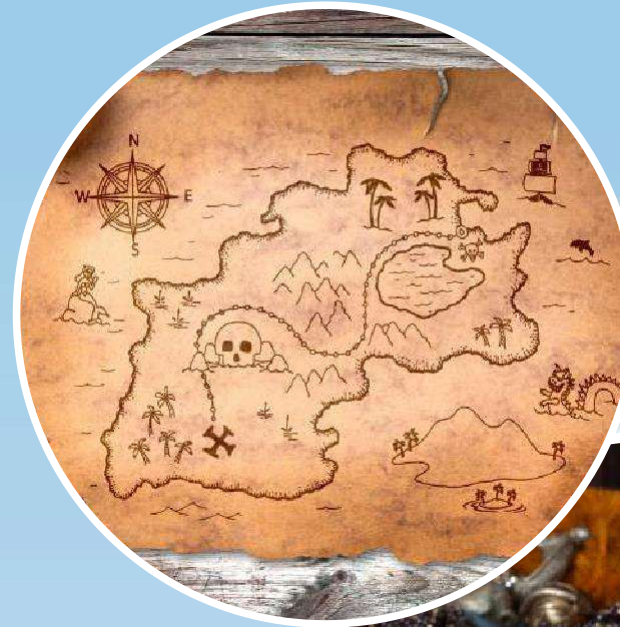
Can you think of anything else a pirate might have had or worn?

Pirates might have used treasure maps to show where they buried or hid their treasure. They could mark the map with a cross to show the spot.

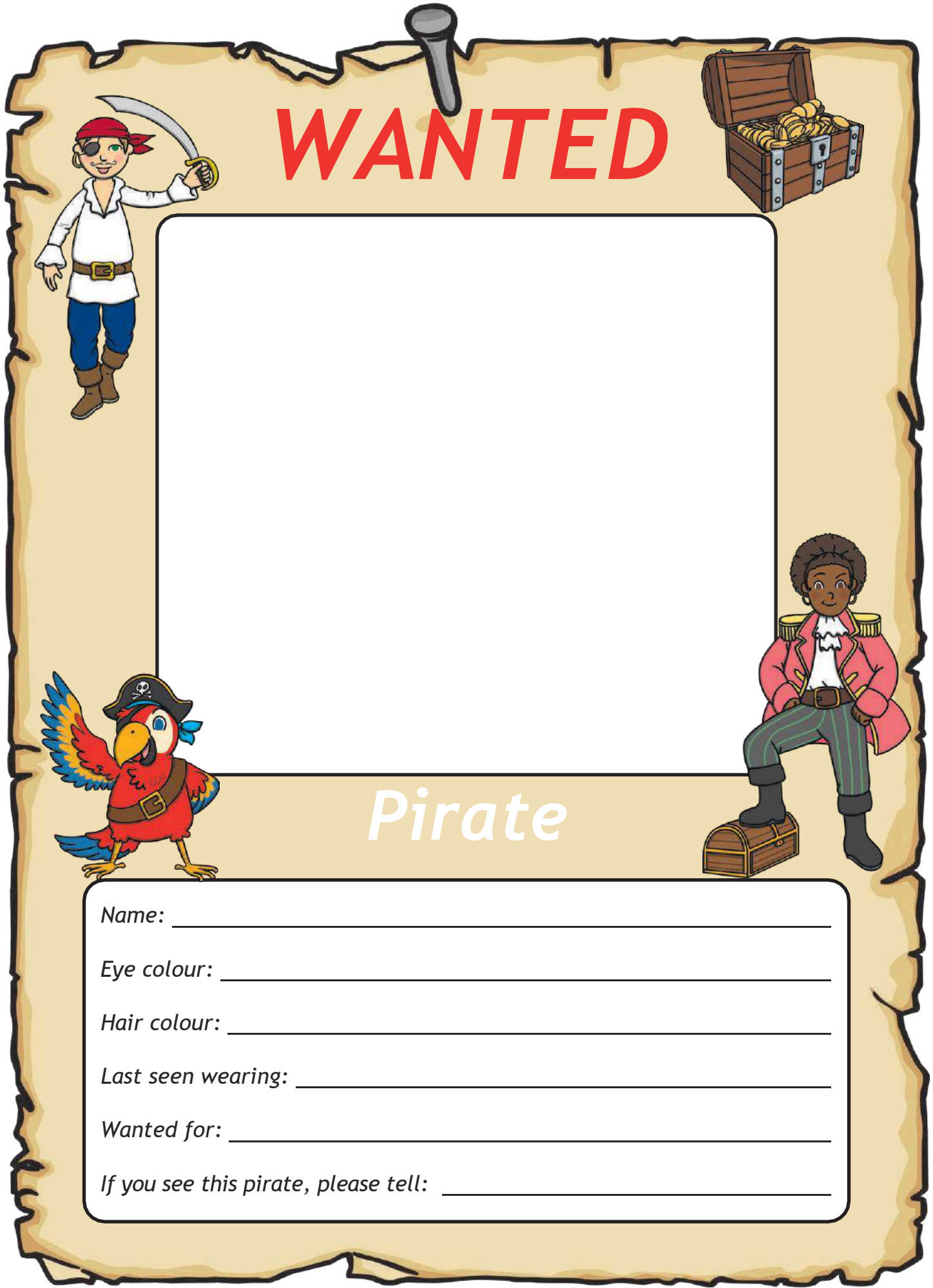
As well as gold and jewels, things that pirates needed, such as food, medicine or supplies for the ship were thought to be treasures.

Pirate Popsicle Stick Puppet Craft

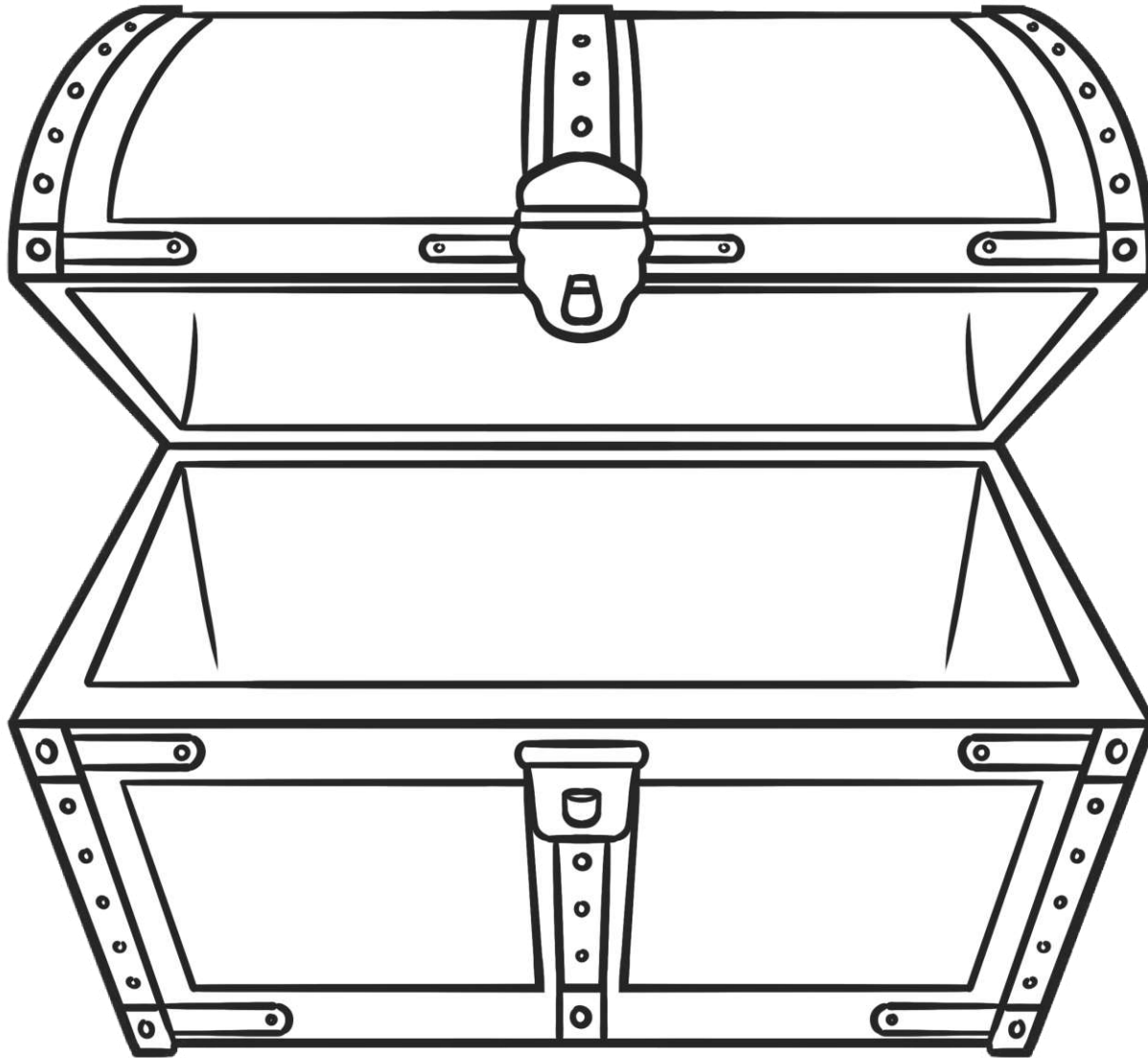
1. Color in the pirate ship.
